WHY FIBER OPTIC INFRASTRUCTURE MATTERS TO YOU

What happens when I sign an access agreement for fiber internet?

When you sign an access agreement, it gives us permission to locate (flag) utilities on your property to put a fiber drop through the ground and tie in by your utilities access. We use a vibrational plow to get the fiber into the ground and our team takes extra care to remediate everything. Usually within a few days you can't even tell we were there! Check how we do it here!



Why sign an access agreement?

Signing an Access Agreement will increase our home and property value with state-of-the-art fiber optic infrastructure is no cost to you. It is incredibly rare for rural Alberta homes to have fiber internet, and we are changing that!



Sign your Access Agreement here!

It allows you to switch to our services seamlessly when you choose, with a very short waiting period. Putting the fiber in is the hardest part, so we want to get that out of the way so that you have access to our symmetrical speeds and unlimited usage whenever you desire!
