Tax Penalties

On January 1, 2024, all unpaid taxes are deemed in arrears. A 15% penalty will be imposed on all property tax arrears in accordance with Bylaw 696/TAX/87. Payments may be made at your local bank, telephone, online banking, mail, or at the Town Office by cash, cheque or debit. Alternatively, payment by cheque (do not drop cash) may be dropped into the dropbox at the west entrance of the Provincial Building. SNOW REMOVAL REMINDER

As snow removal season is here, we would like to remind residents that the Traffic Bylaw (965/TR/2010) states that vehicles parked on the curb must be moved within 72 hours, especially when that roadway is being plowed. We also kindly ask residents to not shovel, push or blow snow back on-to the street when they are clearing their driveways as per Traffic Bylaw (965/TR/2010-Section 19). It makes ridges and ruts that hamper safe driving for private and commercial vehicles.

Please remove your black and blue bins from the street, as soon as they are emptied on Wednesdays, to clear the curbs for the snowplows. Let's all work together to keep our roadways safe this winter!

TO AVOID LITTER AND FOLLOW RECYCLING GUIDELINES

PROPER SPACING
LEAVE 3 ft OF SPACE BETWEEN CARTS, AND BETWEEN CARTS AND OTHER OBJECTS

CARTS MAY BE PLACED ON THE STREET AT 4 PM THE DAY BEFORE SERVICE AND MUST BE REMOVED BY 12 PM THE DAY AFTER SERVICE!
