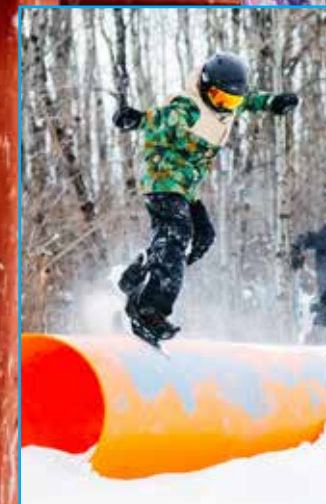

ANIMAL CONTROL

The Town's Animal Control Bylaw dictates that an owner of an animal is guilty of an offence if:

- the animal is not licensed
- barking or howling disturbs others
- the animal causes property damage
- the animal is in an area where a sign prohibits pets
- the animal bites, attacks, barks at or threatens a person or another animal
- the animal defecates on property not belonging to the owner, and the defecation is not immediately removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner

As a responsible pet owner, dogs and cats need to be under your control at all times when out in public areas. Ensure your animal is leashed with control, and carry waste disposal products.

Please respect your neighbour and take proper care of your animals. Your neighbours have a right to peace and quiet in their home, and should be able to walk the streets or trails in safety and without animal disruption.

What do you need for the Development Permit?

Legal Address – Lot, Block, Plan
Civic Address – To determine Land Use Zone

Site Plan – Birds eye view of your property. Includes location of property lines, distance of existing and proposed from property lines, size of buildings, access to street or lane, size of lot

Building Plans – includes floor plan, elevations, exterior finishing

Fees

\$50.00 – For Garage and Additions less than \$25,000.00

\$50.00 – Home based business

\$200.00 – Conforming developments over \$25,000

\$250.00 – Non-Conforming Developments

\$250.00 – Application to Amend Land Use Bylaw, Municipal Development Plan or Statutory Plan

Late Fee – Double above fee, when applying after development has started

Application fees are to recover costs associated with administration time, appeals, notices and advertising.

Planning on building signage, a house, garage, shed, deck, fire pit, adding on or starting a home-based business?

You will require a development permit from the Town of Fairview.

What's Next?:

Construction is not to start until after the issuance of the Development Permit. Permits for discretionary uses or require a variance will be subject to condition that it does not become effective until 21 days after the date of issuance. The decision can be appealed within 21 days.

The proposed development may require building, electrical, plumbing and gas permits which may be a condition of the development permit. You will require the development permit to get the other permits. Building permits and inspections are necessary to ensure construction meets provincial building safety codes.

Sidewalk Snow Removal

BYLAW 1047/GEN/2018 EXCERPTS:

Property owners shall be responsible for removal of dirt or other debris within 24 hours in commercial areas.

The Town of Fairview will clear away snow and ice from sidewalks in residential areas. Commercial areas are responsible for snow and ice removal within 24 hours of deposit.

No person shall place snow, ice, dirt, debris or other material onto roadways or other public places. This includes boulevards or other such areas, as well as the private property of other individuals.

Failure to comply with this bylaw can carry up to a \$100 fine. The Town of Fairview may carry out removal of snow, ice, dirt, debris or other material with all costs involved being charged to the owner of the property.

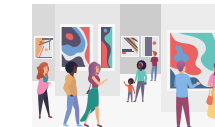

FUN FACTS!

Family & Community Support Services (FCSS) is a preventative social service, not for profit organization that has operated in Fairview for 33 years. Even though it has been around provincially for more than 50 years, you may not have heard much about FCSS. We don't hear about preventing drug and alcohol abuse, preventing crime, preventing isolation, because when prevention works - it's not widely broadcast. Avoiding a crisis isn't news.

FCSS strategically invests in programming that helps to reduce crime, reduce health care dependency, reduce employment barriers for vulnerable Albertans and enhance our economy. Research has shown that for every \$1 invested in preventive services, \$7 - \$12 dollars in future spending is saved. Long-term spending is reduced for justice, health care, and addiction treatment (Heckman, Moon, Pinto, Savelyev & Yavitz, 2010). The Rate of Return to the High/Scope Perry Preschool Program. Journal of Public Economics, 94(1-2), 114-128.

Some of the ways FCSS does this, is by providing information and referral services for resources available locally in the community. Such as through the Fairview FCSS Family & Community Resource Centre, operated in the Fairview Provincial building. As well as the Fairview FCSS Website, the Fairview FCSS Facebook page, and the monthly newsletter, FCSS Corner in the Fairview Post. Fairview FCSS also runs, or funds, numerous other programs and events annually.

Are You Prepared for an Emergency?

1. Know the Risks:

Blizzards, Extreme Cold, Extreme Heat, Floods, Wildfires, Power outages, Winter storms, Tornadoes

2. Make a Plan:

- Plan how and where to meet
 - Where in your home
 - Safe meeting place outside of your home
- Alternate places to stay such as family and friends outside of your neighborhood
- Emergency Exits - Out of your home
 - Out of your neighborhood
 - Out of your Town

3. Educate

- Know the emergency plans in your workplace and your children's school, emergency contact information, the location of fire extinguishers, water valve, electrical box, gas valve, all Family members know how to contact emergency services

4. Have an Emergency Kit

Have some basic supplies so you and your family are prepared to be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours. Make sure your kit is easy to carry and everyone in the house knows where it is. Keep it portable in case you need to leave.

In the event of an emergency in our community, you and your family should be prepared to take care of yourselves for a minimum of 72 hours.

- Water • Food • Manual can opener • Flashlight and Batteries
 - First Aid Kit • Battery operated radio
 - Candles & Matches • Toiletries
- Utensils • Garbage Bags • Basic Tools • Duct Tape
- Pet items • Personal Care items including medications

Town Utility Bills

Your utility bills are mailed out at the beginning of each month (for the previous month's consumption). New radio frequency meters have been installed in almost all the households and businesses. You will receive an accurate monthly bill for actual consumption. You will be charged \$3.00 per cubic meter for residential accounts and non-residential accounts.

In addition to the consumption rate for water you will be charged a flat rate for the Sewer service for residential and non-residential accounts, and a flat rate monthly Capital Replacement fee.

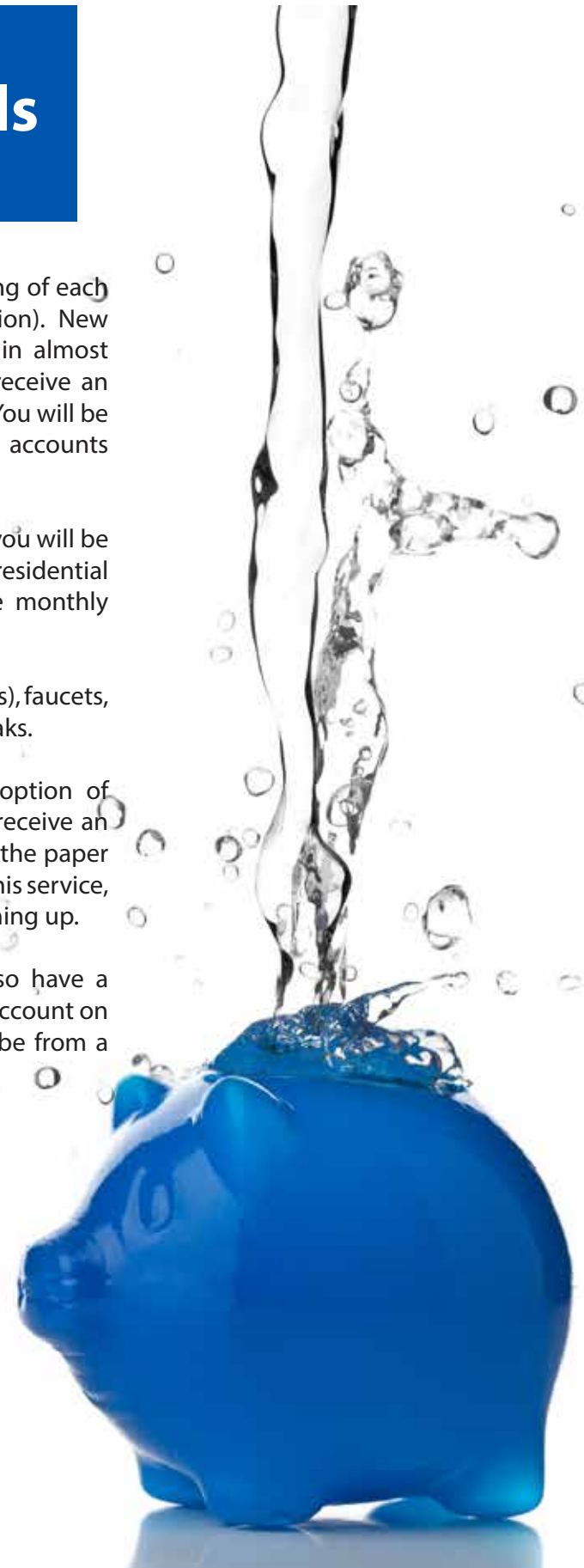
If your bill is exceedingly high, check your toilet(s), faucets, humidifiers, icemakers and outdoor taps for leaks.

We are pleased to offer our residents the option of paperless billing. This means that you would receive an email copy of your bill each month instead of the paper copy in the mail. As an incentive to sign-up for this service, there is currently a \$1 credit per month for signing up.

So you never forget to pay your bill, we also have a preauthorized payment plan that debits your account on the 20th of each month. This debit can only be from a valid bank account.

REDUCE USE CYCLE

All residential garbage and recyclables are collected on Wednesdays by Prairie Disposal's automated collection system. Every residence has been allocated one black bin for household waste and one blue bin for recyclables. The bins are provided at no charge, however if a bin is lost or damaged, the resident will be responsible for the replacement cost. Place both bins on the street with wheels touching the curb, one metre of clearance between each bin and any other object, such as a vehicle.

What can go in the black garbage cart? Any bagged household garbage that you would normally place out for collection should be placed in the black cart. Absolutely no hazardous materials or loose garbage.

What if I can't get all my garbage in the cart? The equivalent of three bags will fit in the cart. If your cart is overflowing (lid will not close), it will not be collected. Additional bags placed at the curb will be picked up if they have a "bag tag" sticker which can be purchased at the Town office.

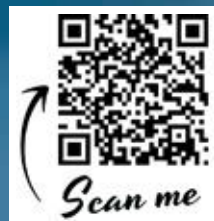
What can go in the blue recycling bin? Newsprint, heavy paper, mixed paper, box board, cardboard, rinsed food cans, rinsed beverage containers, hard plastics #1 to 7 and deposit items.

What should not go into my blue recycling bin? Plastic toys, bubble wrap, plastic bags/film, styrofoam, glass, ceramics, toxic items, electronics, small appliances, diapers, scrap metal or wood, food or yard waste, unrinsed food containers, soiled paper (used tissue or paper towel, pizza boxes smeared with cheese etc.), soiled containers.



Please remove your emptied bins from the street the same day.

This is crucial for both snow removal purposes and general neighborhood courtesy.
