## 2024 PROPERTY TAX REMINDER

Property tax for the Town of Fairview was due on June 30th, 2024. Penalties were applied July 3rd, 2024 at the rate of 15%, on current amount only, except the property owners who are currently enrolled in the Tax Installment Plan.

## Community Standards Bylaw

**Reminding property owners to maintain homes and yards**

**Part III - Nuisances and Unsightly or Dangerous Premises**

### Bylaw Highlights

- do not store abandoned equipment or abandoned vehicles
- do not store household appliances and furniture on the property exterior
- properly dispose of hazardous materials and toxins
- dispose of refuse and debris
- prune trees and shrubs and ensure no encroachment or damage to adjacent properties
- mow grass that is taller than 10 cm
- assess for weeds and invasive species
- no storage of composting material in front yard
- Keep property in a REASONABLE state of repair, including windows, siding, roofing materials, eaves etc.

## PUBLIC NOTICE RE: Town Weed Control



The Town of Fairview will be conducting spraying operations to control weeds on Town property, ditches, right-of-ways, parks, boulevards and sidewalks throughout the summer and fall. Areas to be sprayed include:

Spraying notices will be placed on land to be sprayed two (2) full days before spraying is to commence. Notices will inform of chemical to be sprayed.

Chemicals to be used: Round-Up, Lontrel, and Milestone
