### PROPERTY TAX NOTICES

The property tax notices will be mailed out in May. If you do not receive your property tax notice by the end of May, check the Customer Portal or please email: reception@fairview.ca.

**NOT RECEIVING A PROPERTY TAX NOTICE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A REASON FOR NONPAYMENT.** The 2024 property taxes are due June 30th, 2024 **except for the property owners on the Tax Installment Plan.** 

Notice to the owners of the mobile homes in the Fairview Estates Mobile Home Park – You DO pay property tax to the Town of Fairview on your mobile home.

A penalty of 15% will be imposed on all property tax amounts levied in 2024 that remain unpaid. An additional penalty of 15% will be imposed on all outstanding property tax amounts that remain unpaid after December 31, 2024.

# **BOULEVARD SWEEPING**

Town of Fairview Parks staff will begin boulevard sweeping the residential areas this month. If you **do not** h to have your area swept, please visibly mark off ir grass or place a sign sizable enough for crews to on your grass. If your boulevard was missed please the office or Cole Wiebe at 780-834-7239. Please y back 30 meters. Sweepers create a dust cloud and erators sight line is limited.

The grass bin will be back! Please do not put grass clippings into the blue bin. The only items that should go in the blue bin are newsprint, heavy paper (magazines), flyers, mixed paper, boxboard, cardboard, cans, beverage containers, and hard plastics #1 - 7. Contaminated loads of recycling end up in the landfill instead of recycling.
