## GRASS BIN REMOVAL

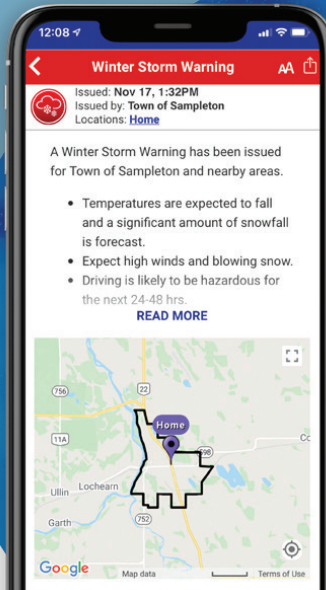
The grass bin will be removed the week of October 14th for the season. It will return in the spring as soon as it dries up.
