

Council Highlights November 19, 2024

STARS Update: Glenda Farnden from STARS shared updates on their vital work. In 2024, STARS responded to 4 emergency calls and completed 5 inter-facility transfers in the Fairview area. The Town of Fairview contributes \$10,000 annually to STARS, which operates on a \$34.2 million annual budget. Only \$15 million comes from the province, with the rest raised through fundraising and municipal partnerships. 2025 marks STARS' 40th anniversary, and Fairview has been a proud partner for 18 years.

Budget Planning: Mark your calendar for the next budget meeting on November 26. Council plans to pass the 2025 interim operating and capital budgets, along with the 3-year operational and 5-year capital plans, at the December 17 meeting.

Tax Recovery Costs: The town recently sold four vacant tax recovery lots, which required significant cleanup due to unsafe structures. These costs, added to the tax roll, left an outstanding balance of \$123,679 after the sales. This amount is considered a "written-off" expense for the 2024 budget.

RCMP Town Hall: The RCMP will host a Town Hall on December 4 at the Friedenstal Hall.
